ADDITIONAL NOTES

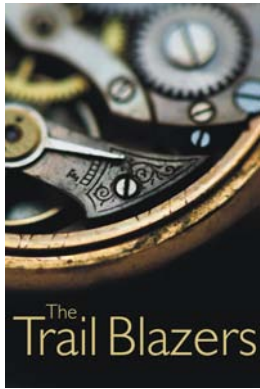
